Accused of child abuse

Dear Advisor,

I have not seen my children for several months. I have been accused of physical and sexual abuse of the children.

The accusations were investigated by An Garda Síochána and by the Child and Family Agency (TUSLA) and every time, after the Gardai and TUSLA found that the allegations are unfounded, new allegations are made

Dear Target Parent,

There is no short cut solving this problem. I suggest that you update your knowledge on a few aspects before you act. Go and study the following documents. It may help if you print it out as a reference the relevant documents on what child abuse is and the revised version of offences regularly committed during the alienation process.

You may want to listen to a talk on said offences that was recorded. It is available in 4 parts at <u>https://</u> <u>www.youtube.com/user/mjstudioIE</u>. Note any offence you identify, where sufficient evidence exist, for the investigating officer to follow up. You may identify several other offences that should be reported.

At this stage you should note all the offences in chronological order. You might have to enlist the help of a legal professional (criminal) or another knowledgeable person. If you have a friend or family member serving with An Garda Síochána, it will be a great advantage.

When you go the Garda station, you might encounter difficulty to get your report accepted. I suggest that you print the document "<u>The Gardaí</u> <u>does not want to help me</u>" and ask the member to read it. Note the name and number of the member you spoke to. This is needed for follow-up or if you have to complain about your case not being accepted.

Hereunder I have attached a redacted witness statement, similar to your issue, that was pre-drafted and accepted by the Gardai.
